Summer Camp General Information

♫ **HOURS:**

All camps begin at 9:00 am and end at 4:00 pm.

♫ **SUPERVISION:**

Students **WILL NOT** be supervised before 8:30 am or after 4:30 pm.

♫ **DROP OFF / PICK UP:**

Students are to be dropped off and picked up in the “game room” which is the same room that you check in on Monday morning. Parents / Guardians should accompany students to sign in and out.

♫ **CAMP DAY:**

The average day is divided into two morning sessions and two afternoon sessions with a morning and afternoon break and an hour lunch break. Each camp is structured in it’s own unique way with sessions focusing on such things as technique development, scales, sight reading, All State repertoire, learning new literature, ensemble playing, etc.

♫ **LUNCH:**

A “school-type” lunch will be provided—pending government funding. Students can bring their own lunches. Low cost snacks and drinks will be available.

♫ **FRIDAY RECITAL:**

Parents and friends are invited to attend a performance every Friday at 3:00 pm that showcases the camp students of the week. The recital will take place in the “cafetorium.” A special evening concert will take place at Gulf Coast Town Center for the Rock Band and Jazz Band camps.

♫ **CAMP FEE:**

Each camp fee is \$125 which includes a specially designed T-shirt which is limited to one per student regardless of the number of camps in which a student enrolls.

♫ **REGISTRATION:**

Space in some camps is limited, so register early. To register, fill out the form in this brochure and send it in with your payment. Once received, you will be sent a confirmation sheet with a map & directions.

♫ **INSTRUMENTS:**

Students must provide their own instruments for all instrumental music camps except Piano/Keyboards and Latin Percussion. Drummers should bring their own drum set for Jazz and Rock Band Camps. Students should mark all of their own equipment with their name.
